	The District Councillors' report had been circulated and the following points were noted:	
	<ul> <li>Work has started on repairs to Benson Weir</li> <li>Photo ID will be needed to vote in the forthcoming police and crime commissioner election on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May</li> <li>A survey for town and parish councils on climate action is open until 18<sup>th</sup> April</li> <li>SODC's work at the riverside to provide facilities for the Wallingford accessible boat club has been postponed until September due to the floods. Until then the club will continue to operate out of Benson.</li> <li>From 14<sup>th</sup> April, the 136 bus to Cholsey will be re-routed with a break in Wallingford and journeys through Crowmarsh will be served by a 139 service, operating in a clockwise loop via RAF Benson and Clacks Lane. These changes will result in travel delays and no through bus from Crowmarsh to Cholsey. There has been no consultation with parishes before implementing these changes although Benson Parish Council was notified.</li> <li>District Councillor Cooper has consulted the planning officer about the Newnham Manor development. A traffic survey was to be carried out regarding school journeys.</li> <li>It was reported that the Rural Services Network are able to offer grants from time to time and SODC can offer advice on grant funding.</li> </ul>
